Matthew J. (Matt) Dolan is a Director in the Federal Policy Group, a division of Clark & Wamberg LLC. In this role, he advises clients on a wide range of regulatory and legislative matters.

Mr. Dolan works to identify and implement effective solutions to complex policy issues in a wide variety of areas. During Mr. Dolan's tenure at Baker Hostetler, he served at various times as head of both the firm's government policy practice and the firm's Washington tax practice.

Before joining Baker Hostetler, Mr. Dolan served as Finance Committee Counsel to Senator David Durenberger. As counsel to Senator Durenberger, Mr. Dolan was responsible for legislative matters under the jurisdiction of the Finance Committee, including all tax and revenue measures and health care reform proposals.

In addition to his role as counsel to numerous nonprofit organizations, charities, and educational institutions, Mr. Dolan also serves a number of such organizations in a volunteer capacity. Mr. Dolan is an officer and director of the Todd Wagner Foundation, a philanthropic organization which funds, among other initiatives, educational programs for disadvantaged youth in cities across the country. He also serves on, and formerly chaired, the board of Archbishop Carroll High School in Washington, a central city school operated by the Archdiocese of Washington. In addition, Mr. Dolan is a member of the board of the Spanish Catholic Center, a division of Catholic Charities which serves the immigrant community of Greater Washington. Mr. Dolan was a member of the Maryland State Council on Child Abuse and Neglect, a gubernatorial appointment, from 2003 to 2007, and in that capacity participated in the oversight of state programs which assist the state's most vulnerable children. Mr. Dolan also serves on the board, and is a past president, of the Yale Club of Washington, and has been appointed as a delegate to the Association of Yale Alumni Assembly.

Mr. Dolan is a member of the District of Columbia Bar Association, the Maryland State Bar Association, and the State Bar of Texas.
